Academic Activities

Philanthropic Activities

- Since its formation the Physics Alumni Association, even with its limited resources, has tried to provide financial assistance to needy students as well as to different welfare organizations.
- In 2016 Rs. 3000/- was given to 3 (2UG and 1PG) students of the dept. For both the years 2018 and 2019 a total of Rs. 6000/- (Rs. 2000/- per student) was shared by 3 (2UG and 1PG) students.
